

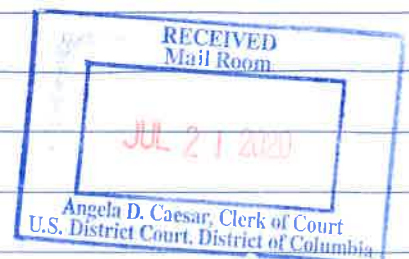

## FACTS


- 1) The Plaintiff sent a FOIA/PA, Freedom of Information Act (Privacy Act) request to the Defendant on April 20, 2020 for all records concerning the Plaintiff personally in the US Embassy in Belize, specifically but not limited to the RSO in Belize, from 2007-2008. The Defendant has acknowledged receipt of this FOIA/PA request and assigned the reference number F-2020-05968.
- 2) The Defendant summarily denied the request because the request "does not reasonably describe the records sought." (Exhibit A).
- 3) The Defendant's employees have willfully withheld documents/records that the Plaintiff has reasonably described including in said description subject, timeframe, names of individuals, title of individuals, and the reason why the Department has the records.
- 4) The Defendant's employees physically tortured the Plaintiff while in Mexico in 2009-2010 while the Plaintiff was being imprisoned in Mexico pending extradition to the United States.

5) The Defendant as an agency of the federal government was a member of the prosecution team in the case US v Day, 3:07-cr-154 (JAG)(E.D. VA.) and is willfully withholding records that prove the Defendant's employees were active pre-trial investigative members of the prosecution team in said case.

6) The Plaintiff seeks the responsive records the Defendant is willfully withholding in violation of the FOIA/PA and any costs involved in the filing and prosecution of the instant case.
