Thank you for filing your FOIA request online on 2/13/2019. Here is a review of your request.

The records I request can be described as follows:

I am requesting to see and hold the documentation the Honduran Presidential Candidate, Salvador Nasralla, presented the State Department to show the elections in Honduras might have been tampered with due to an Amazon Server in Texas counting the votes shutdown and rebooted with flipped results.
