

#### BACKGROUND

The San Diego Sector Intelligence Unit's (SIU's) function with the Sector's scope of operations is to collect data from multiple sources, then target and analyze links to identify Transnational Criminal Organizations. Without data to feed into the system, the SIU cannot be effective at disrupting and dismantling the criminal element that operates in the San Diego Sector's Area of Operation. There are other vendors that collect license plate reader (LPR) data, but all require the buyer to set up a standalone server to access the data. The vendor we have selected collects data into a secured data warehouse and allows access through a secured internet connection. Additionally, Vigilant Solutions has 2.8 billion LPR records which is much more robust than other vendors such as ELSAG, North America.
