The GA HD 132 General Election Survey was conducted by IVR and Online Mobile Interviews from October 1 - October 4 among a random sample of 397 likely voters. The survey has a margin of error of +/- 4.8 percentage points. Results are weighted. Some percentages in crosstab reports for this poll may not add to 100% due to rounding.

Are you registered to vote in Georgia?



How likely are you to vote in the November 3rd General Election?









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


















