All,

I wanted to let you know the outcome of this case. As you know, the immigration judge denied the applications for asylum, withholding of

removal and protection under the torture convention. Aguasvivas appealed the judge's decision to the Board of Immigration Appeals. The Board affirmed the judge's decisions denying asylum and withholding of removal. However, the Board reversed the judge's decision denying torture convention relief and the Board granted Aguasvivas protection under the torture convention. Therefore, Aguasvivas is under a final order of removal but he can't be removed to the Dominican Republic due to the Board's decision that he was entitled to protection under the torture convention.

Thank you for your assistance and support during the litigation of the case.
