


**IDENTIFICATION:** 

This is a 40-year-old African American female gravida 7 para 5-1-0-6, EDC by ultrasound 02/04/2010.

CHIEF COMPLAINT:

Repeat cesarean section.

HISTORY OF PRESENT ILLNESS AND PRESENT ON ADMISSION:

This patient has had 3 vaginal deliveries followed by 3 cesarean sections. The patient has had prenatal care at Valley State Prison for Women. Her dates were confirmed by ultrasound. She is being admitted today for elective repeat cesarean section. The benefits and risks of surgery were discussed with the patient, particularly the risk of bleeding, infection, bladder or bowel injury, or anesthesia complications. The patient understands the procedure and consents to it. All questions were answered. Please refer to the prenatal record attached. The patient declined to have tubal ligation.

PAST MEDICAL HISTORY AND PRESENT ON ADMISSION:

Medical: The patient has a history of anemia and hypertension in pregnancy. Surgical history: As mentioned above, the patient had 3 previous cesarean sections.

SOCIAL HISTORY:

Nonrevealing. The patient has 6 children at home.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION:

VITAL SIGNS: Blood pressure 107/59 mmHg, temperature 97°F, pulse 87, respirations 20. GENERAL APPEARANCE: Young thin African American female who is not in acute distress.

SKIN: No rashes.

HEAD: Normocephalic. **EENT:** Within normal limits.

NECK: Supple and free.

HEART: Regular sinus rhythm. No murmurs.

LUNGS: Clear.

BREASTS: No masses.

ABDOMEN: Soft. Uterus gravid at term with good fetal heart tones, previous cesarean section scars,

vertex presentation.

BACK: Free with no CVA tenderness.

EXTREMITIES: No edema or clubbing. Normal peripheral pulses.

PELVIC: Normal marital introitus. Vagina is clean. Cervix is closed. Membranes intact. Vertex

presentation. Adnexa negative.

RECTAL: Negative.
