Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(f), the United States Probation Boise Idaho Office shall respond to and provide the documents by FOIA Request, created while conducting probation supervision for David Hoffman (043 46 0533) during the years of 2010-2013.

David Hoffman is requesting full copies of all poly-graph exams conducted between Debord Polygraph and David Hoffman. These exams show 100% pass on crucial questions that would have been the sole concerns of U.S Probation during supervision. These exams were done BEFORE the end of 2011 but most likely within 2010. The exams showing 100% pass are the questions which ask of sexual preference and history which was concluded to show zero reaction to exam questions and a 100% pass. Yet these facts have intentionally been ignored and hidden.

Please be advised one such test taken by Hoffman and examined by Debord Polygraph was INCONCLUSIVE. It is the only such report in the series of exams. That same exam was conducted a second time and was passed at a level of 100% by Hoffman as concluded by Debord Polygraph. This exam is the exam taken twice which is requested. While the U.S. Probation Dept. has advised all exams are the property of the U.S. Court and Hoffman does not dispute this fact, it serves zero purpose for U.S. Probation or the Court to hide such a report as described from Hoffman or anyone else in the world. Note, Denis Debord has not responded back to phone calls causing Hoffman to believe Debord is either ignoring Hoffman's request of exam copies or he does not have any copies after such a long time.

Therefore, it is not reasonable to believe the U.S. Probation Dept. does not have access to the inconclusive and same exam of 100% pass in U.S. files so stated

above. And because it serves zero purpose to hide such a report, it is reasoned the Boise Office of U.S. Probation, that being Station Chief David Congdon should have no interest in withholding this exam as it was stated to Hoffman by Congdon in an email Congdon had no issue of concern with Hoffman obtaining said copies from Debord. Since Debord is not likely to have any copies after such a time, under this logic, Congdon could not possibly have any objection to U.S. Probation suppling requested copies. While the U.S. Court may own said file, it is the observation of this writer that all court files are public record. If this argument fails, the idea of not producing such a report to the person examined is not reasonable and there must be some hidden motive to not supply exams requested. Is the 100% pass a problem for U.S. Probation for some reason?

It is requested the U.S. Probation Dept. respond by mail or email to David Hoffman within the 30 day period allowed under FOIA and that this examination both inconclusive and the same exam of 100% pass be given as per FOIA.

Expected to be provided is;

1. All Polygraph exams conducted by Debord Polygraph on David Hoffman and recorded in U.S. Probation records before year 2011 end date.

Mr. Hoffman,

In general terms, our records remain the property of the U.S. Courts. Because the courts are excluded from the Freedom of Information Act, and the Privacy Act, your potential request would not be fruitful. However, treatment records, such as the polygraph exam you referenced, are considered the property of the treatment provider. Therefore, you should be able to get a copy directly from DeBord Polygraph after you complete whatever release of confidentiality form(s) they require. Good luck.
