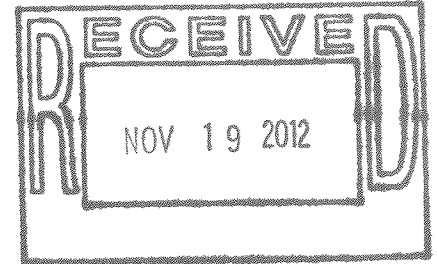

This is in response to your November 11, 2012, voicemail message concerning your Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (CDC/ATSDR) Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request #12-01072-FOIA.

As we advised in our acknowledgement letter, CDC processes all FOIA requests on a first-in, first-out basis, which is the court-approved method for agencies operating under a backlog. Program staff have completed their search for the records you requested, and your case is currently in this office awaiting final review. Processing time is contingent upon the number of requests ahead of yours and their complexity and volume. Therefore, we are unable to give you an exact timeframe for completion of your request. Please be assured, however, that a response will be sent to you as quickly as possible.
