Here is what I was able to get to the responses to your questions:

1. Symplicity's quote references an excluded agencies and office list that should be attached but is not. Can you please send me the agencies and offices that will be excluded from my request?

It's worth noting that these excluded agencies will only have their contact information excluded, not the various notices themselves which will still be provided. This is the result of a General Counsel decision that restricts the aggregation of DoD / DHS points of contact data.

each CSV. This is not necessary as I will not be using excel to open these files. I am a software developer by trade and possess the tools necessary to extract data from a large CSV of any number of rows. Please indicate if this item is the main reason for the number of hours in the quote and

This request is in the millions of rows of data (ex. FY12 is almost 400,000 rows) given the date range that is requested. We can inquire with our tech team if a single file is possible, however the cost would likely not change as this single line item is for the entire process associated with the data pull.

3. It says that point of contact information for the contract notices will be excluded. Are you invoking a FOIA exemption for this portion of the data? Please clarify.

Only the contact information of the above bullet-ed agencies will be excluded.
